- water harvesting policy

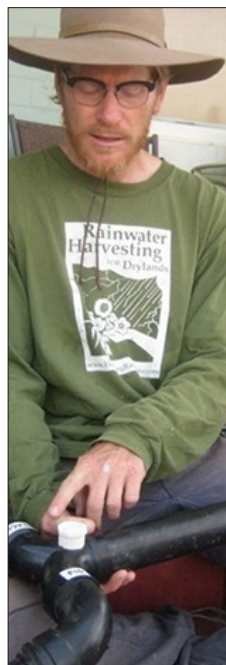
