NOTE – PRESENTATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR UPLOADING DURING THE CONFERENCE

Papers are invited from researchers and students of green roofs and green roof related topics.

Presentation slots will be 15 minutes long with 5 minutes for question after each speaker.

Abstracts of papers must be submitted by **25th February 2011**. The abstract will not be peer reviewed, however there will be a selection panel who will invite speakers to present their papers.

If accepted as abstract, the full paper or a revised abstract must be submitted by **25th March 2011**, with no further review. Papers will typically be no more than 1,500 words in presentation. All presented papers will appear in the Conference Proceedings on the Green Roof Centre website after the event.

Content must be scholarly. Papers will normally deal with a significant research project, or theoretical issue. Typically papers will detail context, aims, methodology, findings and conclusions.
